

2 DAYS | GILGANDRA AND TOORAWEENAH

Day 1 - Gilgandra...

START WITH A COFFEE AND WANDER GILGANDRA'S MAIN STREET

A country town wouldn't be complete without a great main street - and that's just what you'll find on Miller Street! Restaurants, cafes, a bakery, boutiques and gift stores are all within a short walk.

TAKE YOUR BIKES, SCOOTERS, AND PRAMS ON THE WINDMILL WALK


Follow the cut-out Coo-ee marchers along the 2km (one way) trail and find out why Gilgandra is known as the town of windmills. You'll also walk along the 'upside down' Castlereagh River, a natural marvel that will have kids and adults alike scratching their heads.

STEP BACK IN TIME AT OUR MUSEUMS & GALLERIES (COO-EE HERITAGE CENTRE TEMPORARILY CLOSED FOR RENOVATIONS)

Linked by the Windmill Walk, you'll find there's plenty of history to soak up at the Coo-ee Heritage Centre and Gilgandra Museum.

You'll feel the Coo-ee spirit of mateship and community at the Coo-ee Heritage Centre as you learn about the 1915 Coo-ee March, get a taste of history and see the exhibitions from local and regional artists.

Then, discover life throughout history, with interactive displays and plenty of machinery to inspect at the Gilgandra Museum. See an original Howard Rotary Hoe, which was invented right here in Gilgandra! You can also see our place in the World's Largest Solar System Drive - we're Neptune!







ENJOY LUNCH

Before relaxing for the afternoon, grab a bite to eat at one of Gilgandra's many country pubs, or find a cafe that takes your fancy.

You might like to sneak in a quick 9 holes at the Gilgandra Golf Course.


LET THE KIDS LOOSE AT HUNTER PARK OR HEAD TO THE RIVER FOR A SPOT OF FISHING

Day 2 - Tooraweenah...

GILGANDRA TO TOORAWEENAH 47KM (36MIN DRIVE)

TRAVEL TO TOORAWEENAH AND TAKE IN THE VIEW

Stop by the GK Rohr Warrumbungle Viewing Platform and say hello to the Returned Soldier Sculpture.

When you get to Tooraweenah, you'll be greeted by original 20th-century buildings and magnificent views of the Warrumbungles. If you need a longer break, pop into The Little Gecko Coffee Shop and take a stroll through the historic town.

WHY NOT PLAY ANOTHER ROUND OF GOLF?

Enjoy a round of golf at the Tooraweenah Golf Course.

TOORAWEENAH TO EMU LOGIC 22KM (19MIN DRIVE)

VISIT THE EMUS AT EMU LOGIC

Continuing toward the Warrumbungles, make your way to meet some emus, and grab a coffee and a snack while you're there! This working Emu Farm produces everything from pure emu oil, to emu oil soaps and lip balms. Visit between July and October to see newborn chicks.

Tours and shop opening times change throughout the year, so contact Emu Logic ahead of time to confirm the best time of day for a visit.

WIND DOWN AT THE PARK AND THE MOUNTAIN VIEW HOTEL

Enjoy a home-cooked meal and ice-cold drinks in the friendly Mountain View Hotel. Just across the road, you can let the kids loose on the play equipment at the park. There are also barbecue facilities, shaded eating areas, public toilets and sporting facilities.
